CONVENTION REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Everyone attending the Convention must be registered and must wear their convention badge at all times. Convention badges are required for admittance to all convention activities. This is most critical when attending activities in the hospitality rooms and atrium.
- Register before April 15th to avoid the late fees. Walk-in registration packages take time to prepare so even if you have missed the late fee date, send your registration to Bill McMahan anyway so that your convention package will be ready when you arrive. Remember your wife will need her convention badge to attend the lady's activity Friday evening.
- Grand Knights & Delegates: Convention Registration is separate from Convention Credentials – YOU MUST COMPLETE BOTH.
- Banquet tickets are on a first come basis – send in your registration early to assure seating at the banquet.

No money comes from the general State Council Funds. The Convention depends entirely on the registration fees and Convention Program Ads to balance the books.
