FRANKENMUTH & DEARBORN, MICHIGAN

Plus Henry Ford Museum & Greenfield Village

5 DAYS - 4 NIGHTS

Day 1 - Depart for Cleveland, Ohio for a visit to the Rock 'n' Roll Hall of Fame - featuring seven floors of exhibits dedicated to the art form of rock and roll. Lodging tonight is in the Cleveland area, with dinner at the motel.

Day 2 - Breakfast, then check out and depart for Dearborn, Michigan. Lunch on your own in the cafeteria at the Henry Ford Museum, then enter Greenfield Village where you can spend a couple hours browsing the many historic buildings that Henry Ford bought, painstakingly disassembled, relocated and reassembled here. As you stroll through the village you will also see craftsmen of that era, hard at work. After your visit, depart for your lodging for two nights at the Best Western Greenfield Inn. Check in and prepare for your evening aboard the Detroit Princess Riverboat. Board the riverboat for a 2-1/2 hour "Motown Dinner Cruise" on the Detroit River, featuring a prime rib buffet dinner with entertainment - a tribute to Detroit's own Motown music of the '60s.

Day 3 - After breakfast at the inn, depart for a day in Frankenmuth. Visit Bronner's Christmas Wonderland which features thousands of Christmas ornaments, lights and decorations. Lunch is on your own in the cafe at Bronner's or at a downtown restaurant. You'll have time to browse the shops in the village of Frankenmuth, then head to St. Julian's Winery Tasting Room to sample their delicate wines. Complete your stay in the village with a delicious dinner, served family-style at Zehnder's Restaurant. Return to Dearborn after dinner for a restful night.

Day 4 - Following breakfast, check out and depart for the nearby Henry Ford Museum which covers 12 acres and contains a multitude of artifacts, inventions, and mementos of American history and of Henry Ford's exploits with his close friend Thomas Edison.. Lunch is on your own in the cafeteria, then board your bus for Zanesville, Ohio and your lodging for the night. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant.

Day 5 - Arise to breakfast, followed by check-out and departure for a tour of the Longaberger Basket Factory. Visit the Homestead Shops, featuring other home and lifestyle products such as pottery, wrought iron, fabric accessories and specialty foods. Head homeward after your visit, taking with you wonderful memories of your vacation in Michigan.
