

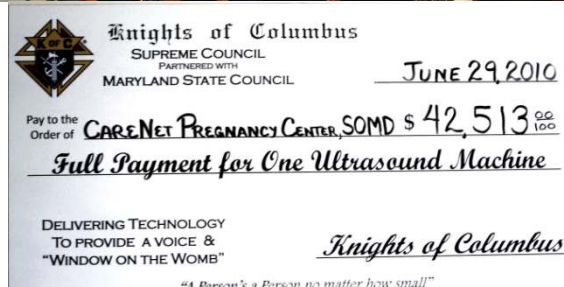
First Sonogram Machine Funded under Supreme Program



Program saves the lives of hundreds of local babies!

Statistics show that 70% of women who consider abortion choose life after seeing an ultrasound image of their child. These families need your help!

The Knights of Columbus Supreme Council is teaming with local Knights on a major initiative to purchase ultrasound machines for the Crisis Pregnancy Centers. Each machine costs approximately \$50,000. The Supreme Council will cover half. The Maryland State Council of the Knights of Columbus launched a campaign to team the entire state with the goal of raising funds for these life-saving machines.



A check for the first machine purchased by Maryland Knights under this program was presented on June 29th, 2010. State Deputy Richard V. Siejack presented a check for \$42,513 to Ms. Cheryl Keen, Director, CareNet Pregnancy Center of Southern Maryland. The machine will be shared by the CareNet centers in Calvert and St. Mary's County.
