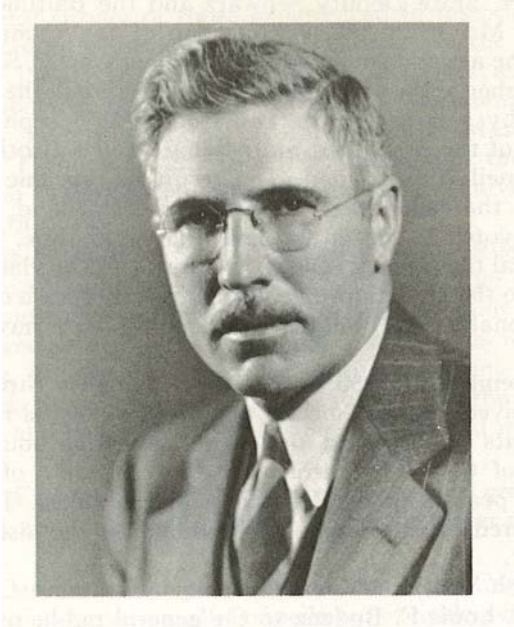


Charles W. Bucy

September 25, 1902 – August 28, 1974
(State Deputy 1951 – 1953)



Charles was born at Westfield, Mass and was married to Emilie K. (Sweetie). They had three children: Charles A., Donald, and Karen Bucy Wasik.

Charles attended Georgetown University School of Foreign Service '23, Georgetown University School of Law '23-25, Fordham University School of Law '26 where he received his L.L.B. He attended the Brookings Institute Symposium on Administrative Law, Policy and Procedure '60.

Charles later served as Asst. General Counsel, U.S. Dept. of Agriculture.

Charles was a member of the American Bar Association, Federal Bar Association, National Lawyers Club, Bethesda Country Club, Kappa Alpha Phi, Foreign Service Fraternity, and the John Carroll Society.

A charter member of Rock Creek Council, Charles moved up through all of the chairs to become the 9th Grand Knight from 1947 to 1948. He continued his involvement in the Knights of Columbus at the State Council level, as District Deputy, State Advocate, and the State Deputy of Maryland.

Charles served as Delegate to six Supreme Conventions, and Chairman of State Council Scholarship Committee. He was a 4th Degree Member.

Upon his death, there was a Christian Burial mass at Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Bethesda. Charles was laid to rest in Gate of Heaven Cemetery.
